

## Park City High School Fundraiser for Toddler with Cystic Fibrosis

PARK CITY, UTAH &ndash; Park City high school will be hosting a fundraiser to support one of their teachers and his family. Bransen&rsquo;s father, Robbie Rauzi, is Park City High School&rsquo;s Health Science teacher. In his classes, students learn about various illnesses. His students now get help support raising awareness for Cystic Fibrosis; which does not yet have a cure.
